Submission Guidelines:

Panel and roundtable proposals should include a brief description of the theme, objectives, and proposed speakers.

Individual paper proposals should consist of an abstract (max. 300 words) outlining the research objectives, methodology, and key findings.

Proposals should be submitted by **30 June, 2024**.

Notification of acceptance will be sent by **15 July, 2024**.

The conference will consider abstracts in English, Russian, German and Kazakh (with English translation).
